Firefighter III

General Statement of Duties:

Engages directly in firefighting, rescue, fire prevention, equipment operation and maintenance, fire station maintenance, community service, training activities or EMS functions in the Division of Fire; does related work as required.

Distinguishing Features of Class:

This is a Career Development Program (CDP) class for which there is no class specification or description. The CDP is administered by the Division of Fire.
